Voyager Requirements – Two Year Commitment

- Matched with an eMentor from the Target Corporation
- Perform 50 hours of community service during your junior and senior year

Voyager Career & Worksite Seminar

A weekly seminar composed of career and work readiness training; personal development; college preparation; classroom guest speakers; and company and college visits.

Voyager E-folio and Certificate

All students are required to maintain an individual e-folio that is developed throughout their two years in the program. The e-folio serves as an assessment for graduation as well as for attainment of the Voyager Certificate that will be endorsed by the Minneapolis Regional Chamber of Commerce and Minneapolis Public Schools.
