Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The ACT test will be administered statewide on Tuesday, April 28th to all 11th grade students. The ACT plus writing test is a MPS District and MN State Graduation Requirement. All students will be released early from school at 1:30 p.m. on Tuesday, April 28th. Students taking Metro Transit buses can board on Lowry or Central Avenue. Students who receive special education bussing will be released at 12:30 p.m.

On the day of testing for 9th, 10th, and 11th grade students:

- 9th and 10th grade students will take a pre ACT test
- 11th grade students will take the ACT plus writing test
- Students will receive lunch at school

On the day of testing for 12th grade, DCD, Autism, and Life Skills students:

- Students will be going on a fieldtrip to volunteer at Feed My Starving Children
- Students who attend the fieldtrip will have a cookout lunch upon their return to Edison
- If your student will not be attending school on Tuesday, April 28th please call the attendance line to report the absence at 612-668-1311

Students should report to school on time at 8:15 a.m. Testing will begin promptly at 8:45 a.m. We have been preparing students on test strategies to reduce test anxiety and to ensure students are familiar with the content of the ACT.
